2. Monitor the implementation of peace and order programs and projects and the operation of civilian volunteer self-defense organizations and such other counter-insurgency programs and activities;
3. Make periodic assessments of the prevailing peace and order situation and submit a report thereon with recommendations to the chairman of the National Peace and Order Council;
4. Perform all other functions assigned by law to the Peace and Order Council.

The Order shall take effect immediately.
